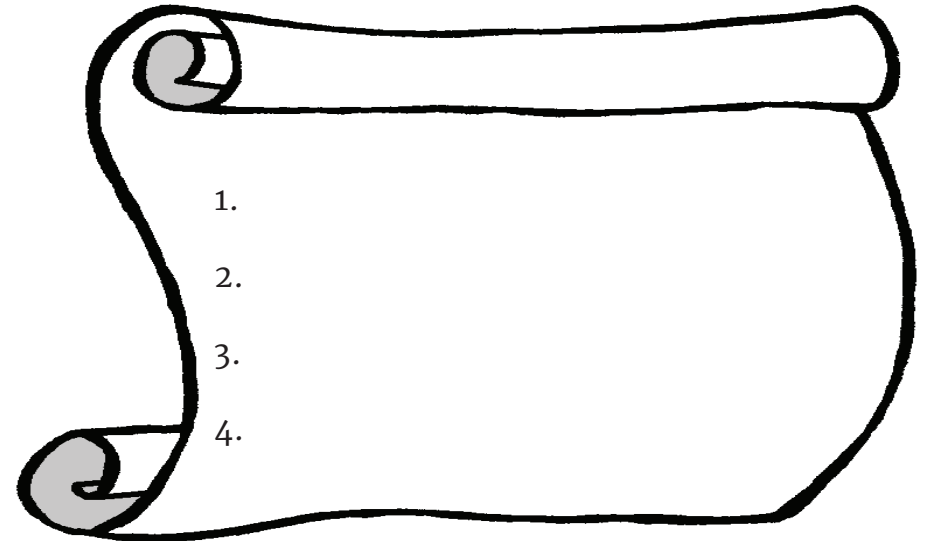
During the season of Pentecost, you will see the color green used a lot in church. Why? Green is the color of life! It reminds us that God's love never turns brown or dies.
