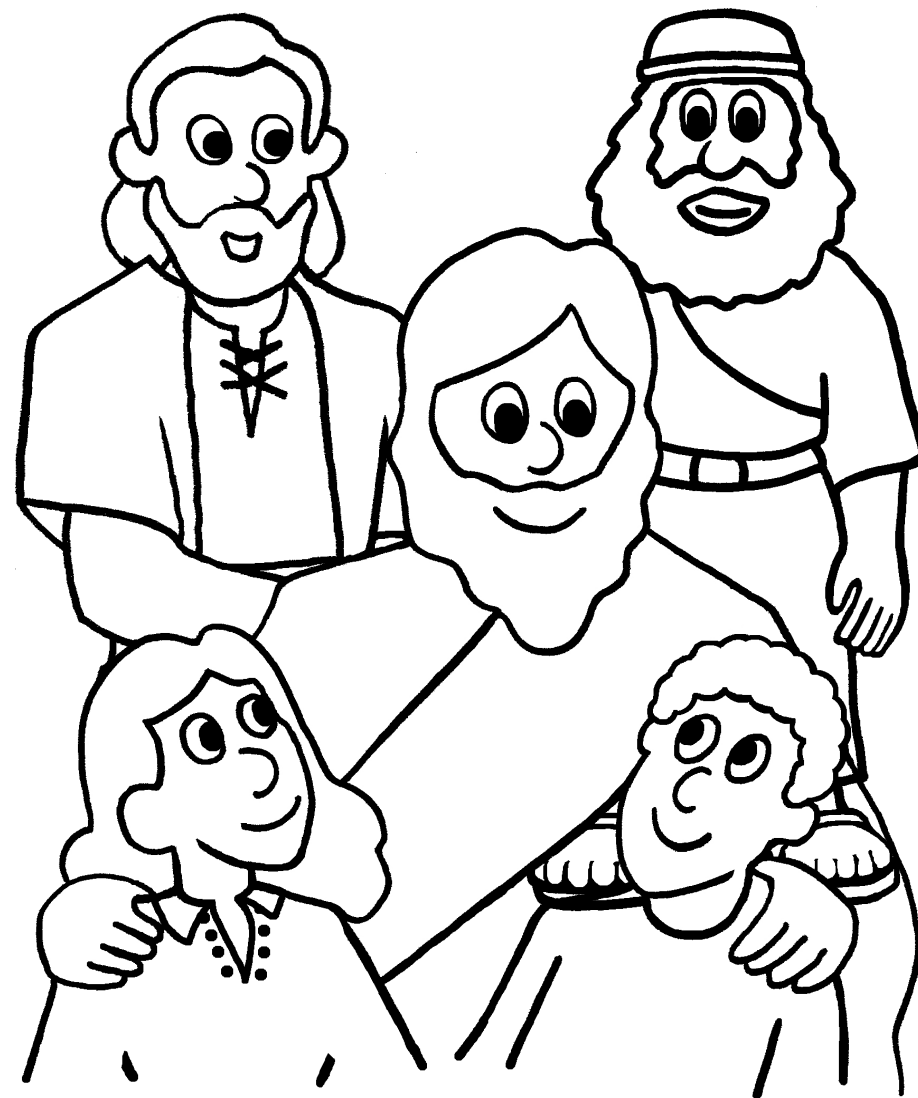

Jesus wanted his followers to be humble like little children.

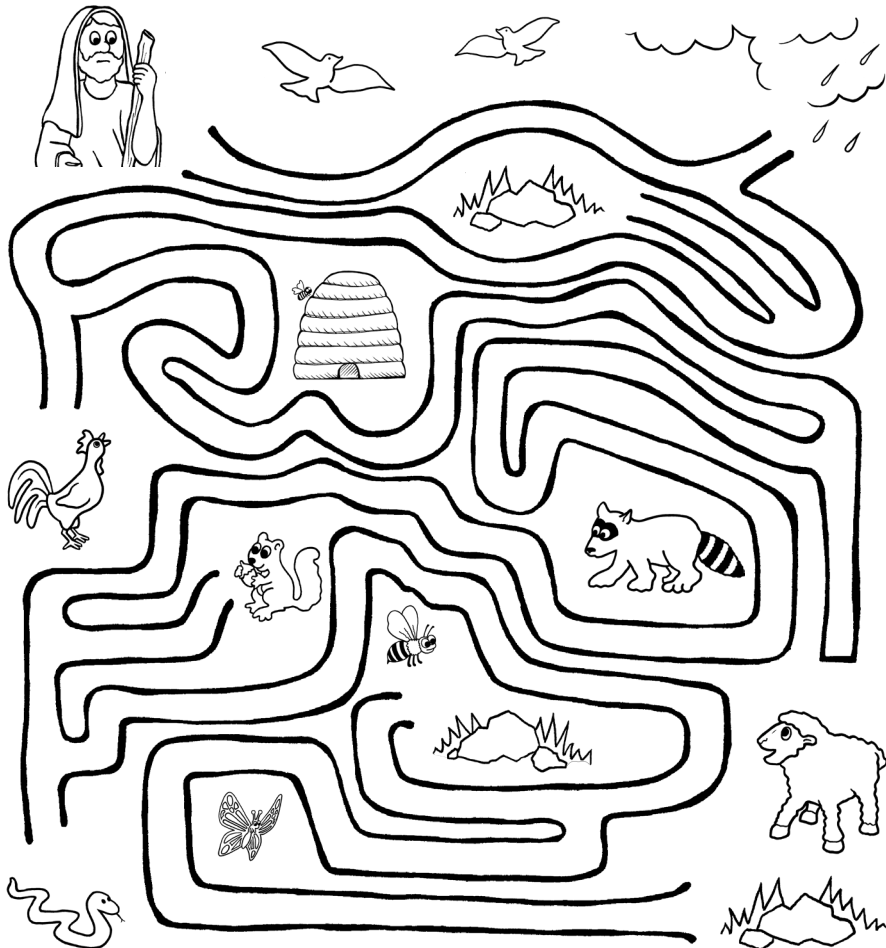

Help the shepherd find his lost sheep in the maze below.

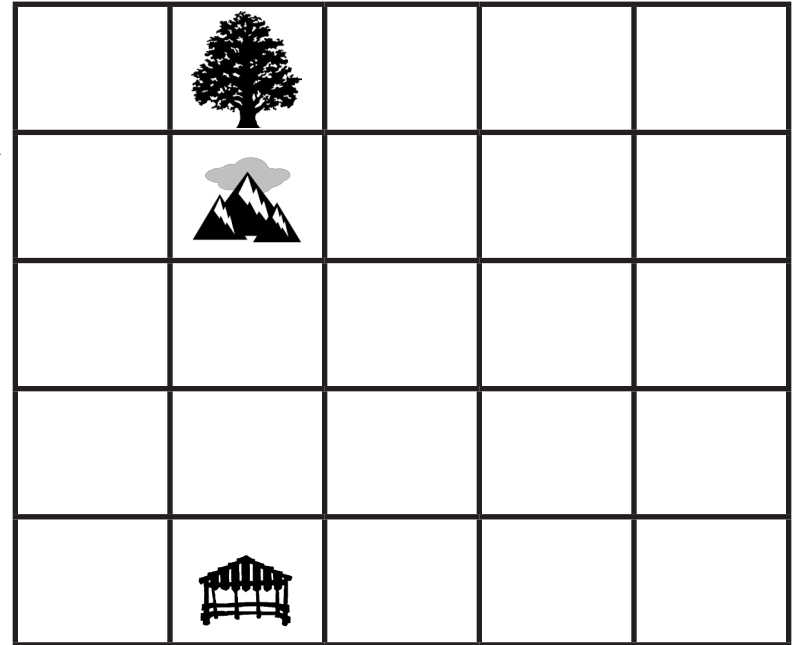


Jesus said, "So it is not the will of my Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish."

Go south one block to the mountain.

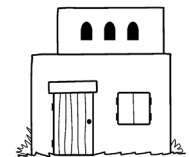
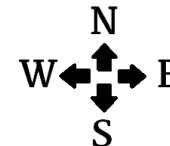
Go east two blocks.
