Now the **tax collectors** and **sinners** were all **drawing near** to **hear** him. And when he comes **home**, he **calls** together his **friends** and his **neighbors**, saying to them, ‘**Rejoice** with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.’ Just so, I tell you, there will be more **joy** in **heaven** over one sinner who **repents** than over ninety-nine **righteous persons** who need **no repentance**.

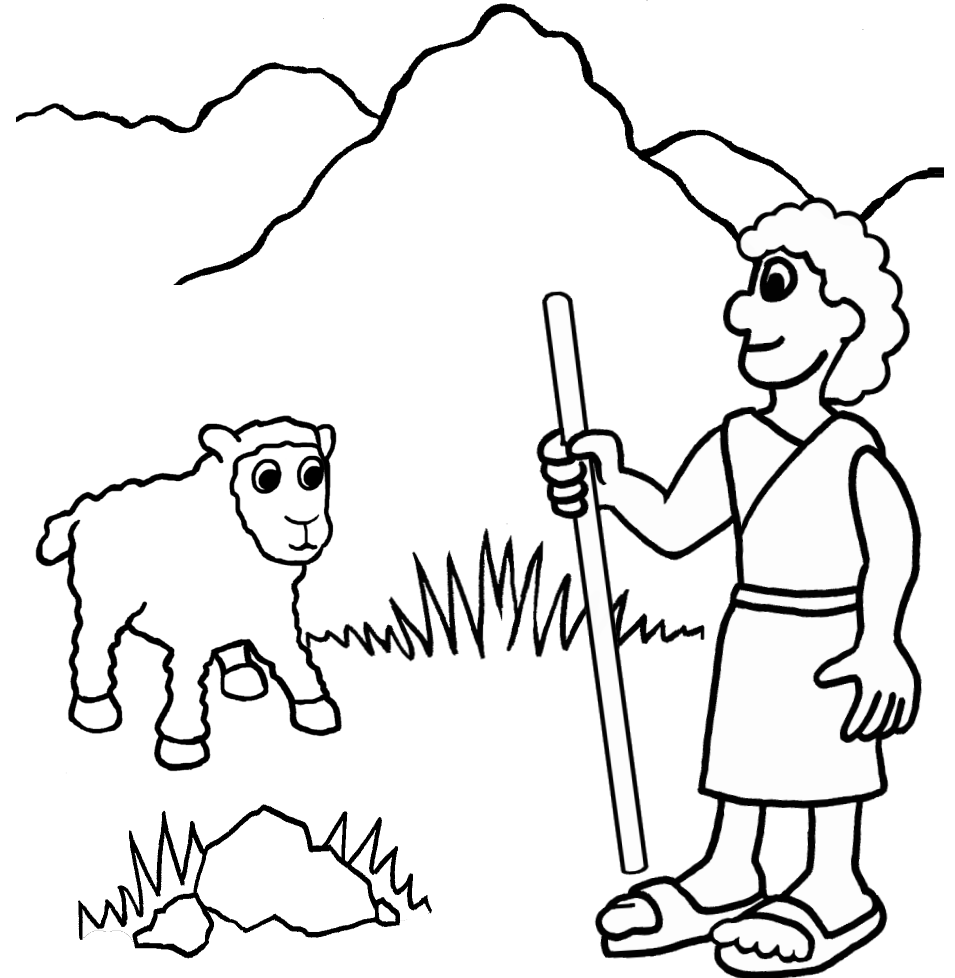

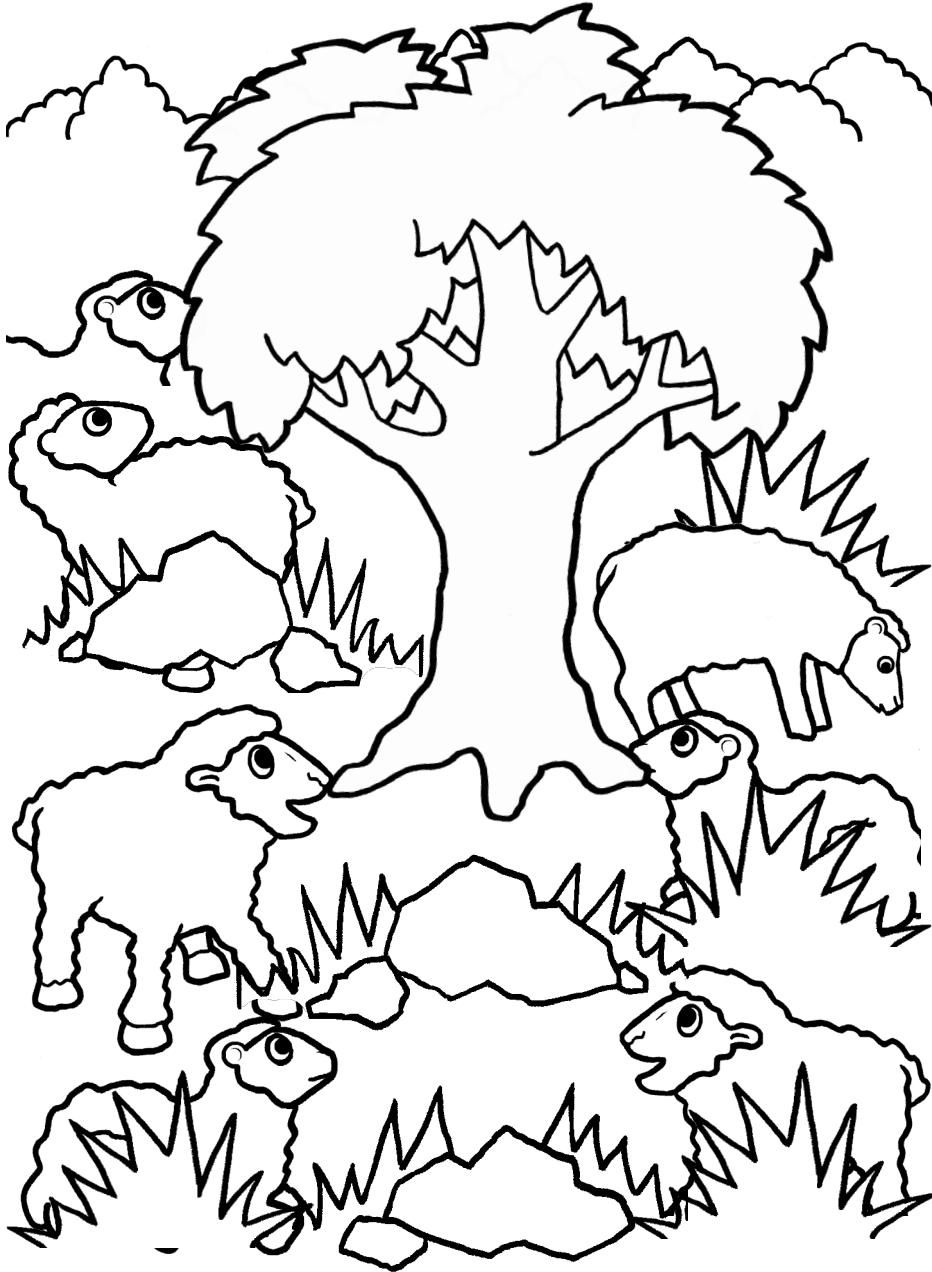


A good shepherd searches for a lost sheep
