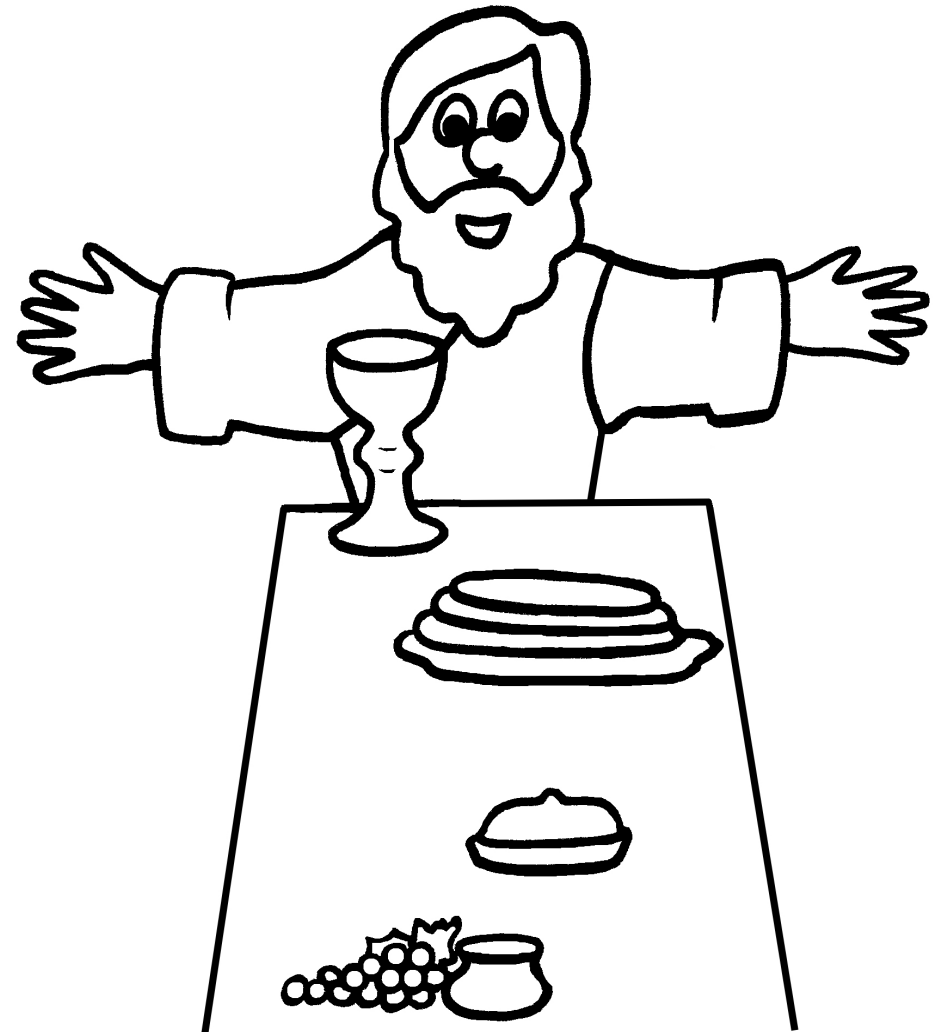

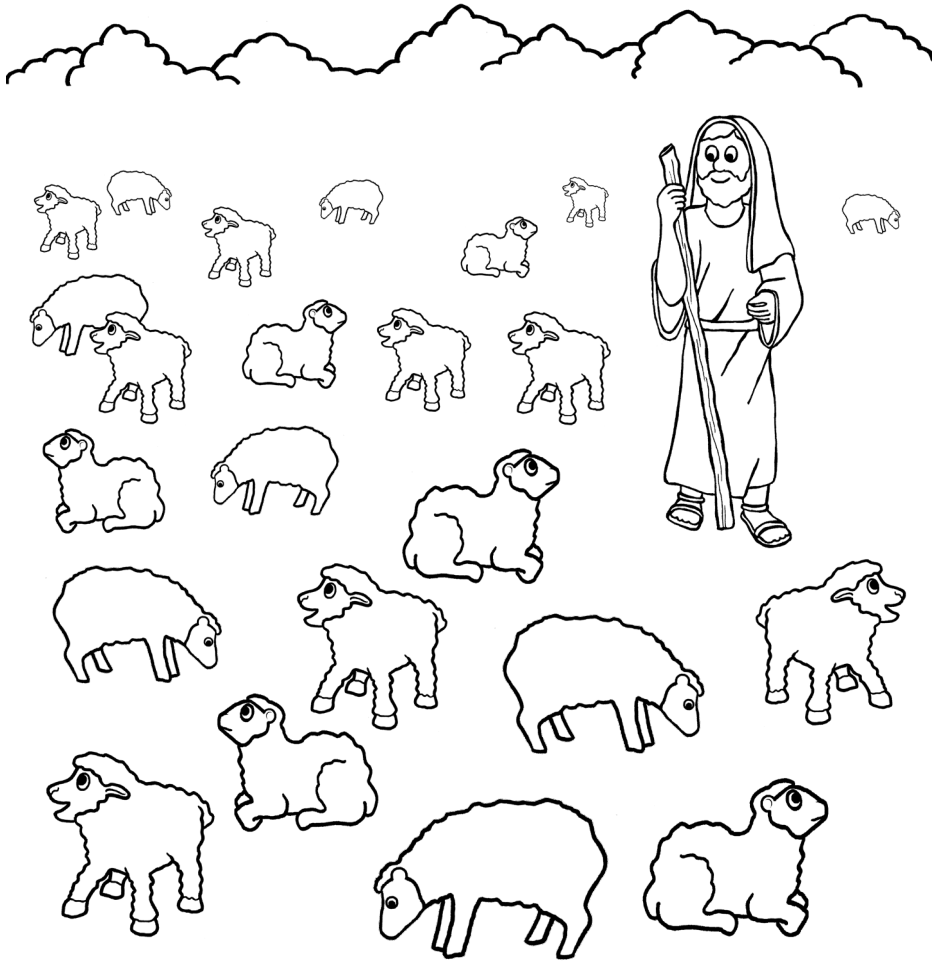

 Then, color the whole picture!



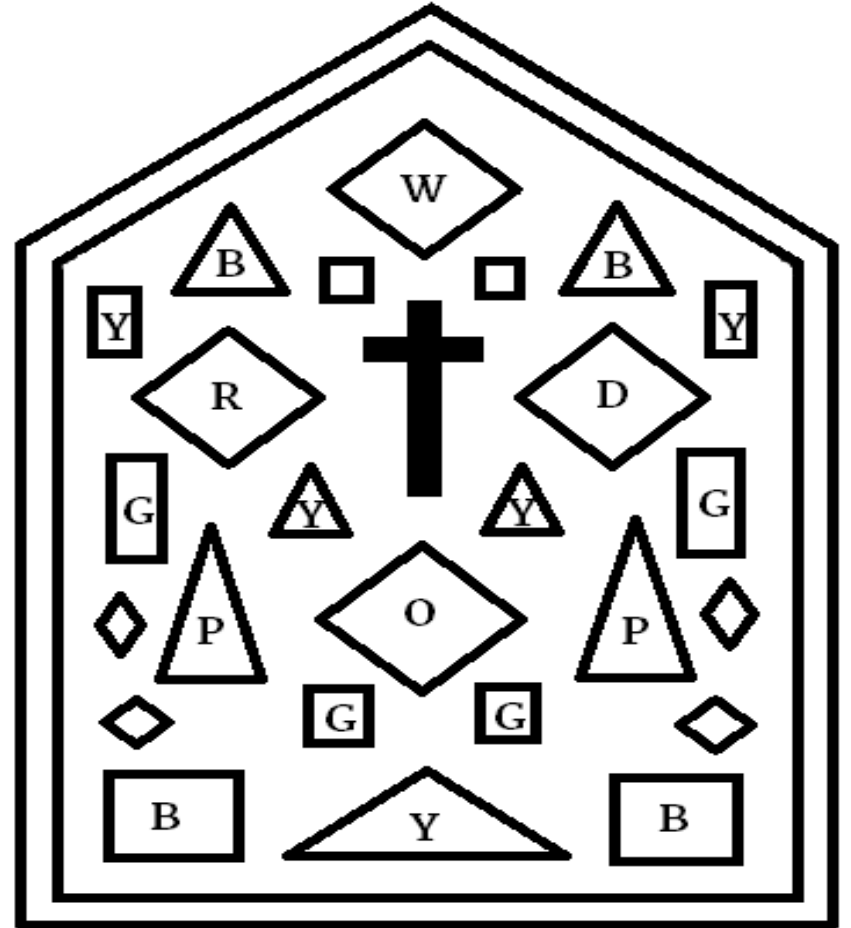
God's commandments are like a fence that protects us.
